




SCHOOL COUNCIL NEWS


1st May 2015

F2B and 2Sharks handed in their designs for the Ark garden on Monday for the Wildlife Trust; we have put in our school entry. Keep your fingers crossed.


Actions:

1. Fatima (Y6) has brought everyone a chocolate biscuit as a thank you to all as Y6 finish their Chair job this week.
2. Thank you to F2B who have designed a Wildlife Garden for the Ark area and 2Sharks who have added some vegetable and fruit planting ideas. We have entered a school entry to the Leicestershire and Rutland Wildlife Trust. Y4 has researched habitats for a variety of animals.
3. Year 4 had a list of issues that they forgot to mention last time; they have been trying to resolve them in Class Council. Mrs Peters has explained that FAB members will go out at break. They will manage equipment for 4 days at break. Year 3 and Year 4 have requested a timetable for sharing the equipment fairly.
