School Council meeting 22nd May 2015

1. 2Sharks have asked for a timetable for the Quasar and the football pitch. They have decided how to use and share the playground equipment sensibly. Y2 are going to have children like FAB club members to help out. Lee would like us to find out how much energy we use in school, it costs about £100 a day to heat and light our school. We made a list of ideas on how to reduce energy: turn off lights when we are not in the room; put computers into power saving mode or turn off when not in use; use green stickers for turn it off at night and red stickers for leave it on (e.g. fridges, server). We need to do a poster about saving energy (competition). We need to do a survey of what power we use. Lee will do an assembly.
