



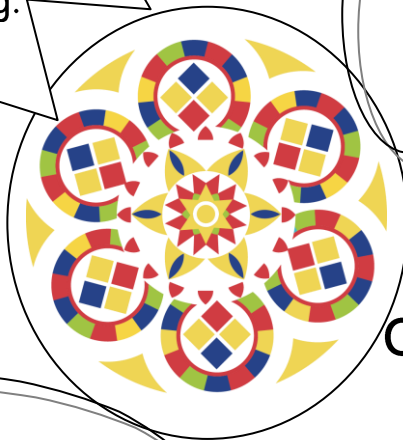
SCHOOL COUNCIL NEWS
