## KITS

Apprenticeships can take between one and four years to complete depending on the level of Apprenticeship, the apprentice's ability and the industry sector. The minimum salary is £3.70 per hour; however, many apprentices earn significantly more.

## CITB (Construction Industry Training Board)

Plastering, scaffolding and carpentry are just a few of over 30 different apprenticeships available in construction. You might be familiar with some of the choices, but there are plenty of others that might just surprise you. A CITB apprenticeship usually lasts between two and four years depending on where you're based and what level of qualification you're studying for. During this time you will be allocated an apprenticeship officer to support and guide you through your training programme.

As an apprentice, you will be in full-time employment, be paid a minimum of £3.70 an hour - many apprentices earn considerably more, gain a nationally recognised qualification, get hands-on experience to help you develop the skills you need to kick start a successful career. On the job training is structured and agreed with your employer to ensure you learn the right skills. Off

the job training is arranged for you at a college or training centre. You can complete this training on day release or over a number of days in a series of blocks.
