The Government introduced new specific duties set out in The Equality Act 2010 (Specific Duties) Regulations 2011 ("the Regulations"), which came into force on 10th September 2011. The Explanatory Note to the Regulations states that the purpose of the duties it imposes is to ensure better performance by public authorities of their duties under Section 149(1) of the Act. The Regulations:

- Require public authorities to publish information to demonstrate their compliance with the duty imposed by Section 149(1). For schools that information must be published not later than 6th April 2012 and subsequently at intervals no greater than one year beginning with the date of last publication;
- Require public authorities to prepare and publish one or more objectives that they think they should achieve to do any of the things mentioned in paragraphs (a) to (c) of Section 149(1) of the Act.

 Objectives must be published by all public authorities no later than 6th April 2012 and subsequently at intervals of not greater than four years beginning with the date of last publication;
- Information must be published in such a manner that it is accessible to the public and allows the information to be published as part of another document.
