

Diocesan Schools Building Fund – What is this?

The Diocesan Schools Building Fund (DSBF) was introduced in order to provide the contribution needed towards building and repair projects at our Voluntary Aided Schools.

This voluntary contribution of 10% to all capital and repair costs of the School allows St Francis Catholic Primary School to maintain a Voluntary Aided Status.

How is St Francis Governor Fund Allocated?

- To fund activities which have been identified as beneficial to, necessary or urgently required for the development of the School.
- Take the place of a school contingency fund to allow the annual budget to be spent in full each year without keeping a reserve. A contingency is required to allow for unplanned expenditure on staffing and buildings maintenance.
- Pay the Residents Association costs of the School.
- Termly contribution to the DSBF
