

Literacy

Speaking and listening - Listening and responding, asking relevant questions, talking about and describing a poem and meanings within poetic writing.

Performing part of a learned poem to perform with intonation and expression.

Reading - reading comprehensions, text extracts and tackling lengthier texts.

Looking at the wider questions and interpretation of text.

Writing - developing different styles of writing linking to poetry (Creating forms). Focus on and writing different types of articles. Structure of writing for an audience, proof reading/editing. Continued use of similes and extending similes.

Grammar & punctuation - continual focus on these, capital letters, full stops, commas, apostrophe, handwriting, tenses, verbs, nouns, adjectives, adverbs.

Science

States of Matter- solids, liquids and gases

Electricity - simple circuits, series circuits, identifying problems and testing equipment.

RE

As a Catholic School we follow the RE teaching Scheme 'God Matters', which this term focuses on Creation, Prayers Saints and Feasts, Advent

Art and Design and Technology

Children will be looking at texture and design and using sketching techniques.

Numeracy

Number: Patterns and sequences of numbers. Counting on and back working with 3 and 4 digit and higher numbers. Place value using number lines, mental maths strategies, rounding to the nearest 10, 100, 1000+, odds and even number recognition. Word problems (multi-step problems), roman numerals, sequences writing column addition, subtraction, multiplication and division with remainders.
