Addition and Subtraction

Adding three single digit numbers

Measurement

Choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate, measure and compare mass (kg/g)

Time: tell the time, including quarter past and to the hour and draw the hands on the clock face to show these times

Position and Direction

Clockwise/ anti clockwise turns.


English
