- have a home postcode in a [POLAR quintile 1 or 2 area](#)
- are the first generation in their family to aspire to enter Higher Education
- have Black, Asian or other Minority Ethnicity
- are a white male with a home postcode in a [POLAR quintile 1 or 2 area](#)
- are a female pupil interested in pursuing STEM subjects
