<p><b>Content covered:</b> How equal is the global supply and consumption of resources? How does the UK use resources? What are the issues associated with water security? How can water supply be increased?</p> <p>Please note- your child will sit an exam in the summer that will involve a pre-release booklet (unit 3). This will be issued in March and we recommend that you spend time looking at this with them at home as exam questions will be based on it.</p>			
<p><b>Literacy and numeracy:</b> <u>Key words:</u> Sustainability, urban, dereliction, urban sprawl, surplus, deficit, water security. <u>Geographical Skills:</u> Graph work, statistical analysis, categorising factors, stating hypotheses, collecting geographical data, presenting data.</p>
