<p>What will my child be studying this term?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How do humans grow and change from birth to old age? • How can we categorise these developments? • What are the stages of our life and what are the key developments in each? • What factors can affect the way we develop? 	<p>Level 1 Pass – Be able to state the main life stages and expected development within them. Be able to state some factors which could affect human development.</p> <p>Level 2 Pass – Be able to describe human development through the life stages and a range of factors which affect them.</p> <p>Merit - Explain and discuss the potential impact of a range of issues which can affect human development.</p> <p>Distinction - Assess and evaluate the potential impact of a range of factors on human development.</p>	<p>Homework will be set weekly. These will take the form of research to inform work in lessons, or writing reports on what they have learnt in lessons.</p>	<p>The opportunity to talk to people with a range of health and social care needs and experiences will give students a broader and deeper understanding of these topics.</p> <p>For example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • People working in health and social care • Expecting and new mothers • Children of various ages • Elderly People • People with ongoing health issues • People experiencing significant life events (moving house / job / school)

Content covered:

Students will be studying physical, intellectual, emotional and social development and when these occur during the key life stages. They will also be learning about a range of factors which can affect development.

Literacy and numeracy:

Students will be using textbooks and the internet to complete a range of research, making informal notes and writing formal reports. Students will be creating timelines of development.
