## Parent Questionnaires- Evaluation

Thank you to the 99 parents who completed our annual questionnaire. This is a fantastic response and provides us with very useful data. All of this is evaluated by me, senior leaders and the Governing Body so that we can work towards making Sunnyfields an outstanding school in every area for children, parents and staff.

Below you can see the combined percentage of responses from parents who agree or strongly agree with each statement. I am pleased that we are above 90% in all areas but recognise that we have work to do in 8 out of 12 areas that are less than 95% as we want them to be as near to 100% as possible. This work has already started with a review of our Behaviour Policy, our priority to gain UNICEF Rights Respecting School status and our new Building Learning Power focus in lessons.
