We recognise the valuable part parents play in their child's education and regard parents as partners in learning. It was reassuring to hear that parents who were able to attend the meeting felt better equipped to help their children at home with maths.

We have arranged another talk for parents of children in Nursery, Reception, Years 1 and 2. It will be given by another specialist, Katie Fuller, who works at Sunnyfields every Friday. This talk is about the value of play and will give support to parents in understanding how to help their children learn through play. **This talk is being held tomorrow, Friday 15<sup>th</sup> January, in the hall at 8:50am.**
