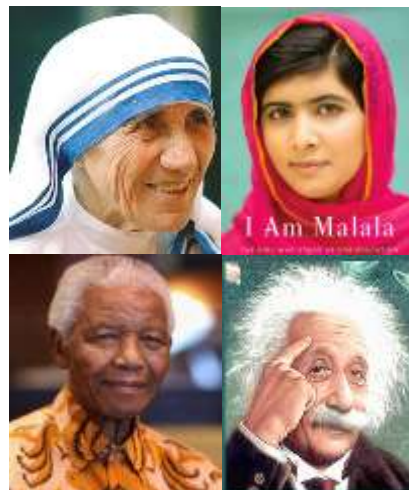
INSPIRATION DAY
