Step-By-Step (SBS) provides a nurturing environment within the school to address social, behavioural and emotional needs and facilitates the removal of any barriers to learning. We encourage the development of:

- self-confidence;
- self-management;
- positive and successful learning;
- strategies to pursue life-long learning;
- maturity to become successful independent citizens in and beyond school.

Drop-In support

Students have a 'Chance to Chat' with Inclusion staff before school, at break or lunchtime if they have pastoral issues they wish to share. The staff can book them a 'Time to Talk' session during lesson time if necessary.

Pastoral Teaching Assistants

We have a team of three specialist TAs, with a solid understanding of a range of needs, who work with students individually, in small groups and in-class.

Pastoral Support

Our aim is to develop strategies to build positive relationships and to address the issues that are barriers to learning to enable the students to achieve their potential.

Students are supported in addressing their learning needs by specialist staff in a friendly, positive and stimulating environment.

Group work

Students are referred for group work generally by their Year Learning Co-ordinators or internally by Inclusion staff. The interventions include:

- Behaviour Modification
- Social skills and Self-Esteem
- Emotional Literacy
- Anxiety Management

Each intervention has a baseline and end-point assessment in order to ensure that the programmes are correctly targeted and effective.
