



Dear Parents and Carers

We have been informed by Lewisham Council that a climate change demonstration is planned to take place in the local area on Friday 14th June 2019. It is anticipated that there may be significant disruption to traffic flows throughout the borough. Areas that may be targeted include Catford by the Broadway Theatre, Deptford outside the cinema and Lewisham Central by the railway bridge.

It is therefore important that all students who use public transport or car for their journey to school allow extra time for their trip to school on Friday morning. Students should allow significant amounts of extra time for delays and anticipate that they may need to walk some of the way to school. This is of the upmost importance for students sitting GCSE or A Level exams that morning. All Year 11 students should sign in at the main school hall on arrival at school in the morning.

We would be grateful if you could talk with your child about this situation and ensure they have a clear plan in place if there is a delay. School should be contacted at the earliest possible opportunity if there is a delay for any student meaning they will be late to school. This is particularly vital for anyone sitting a GCSE or A Level exam.
