GCSE Performance Score

The Performance Score was developed to provide a sensitive measure of students' performance in all subjects taken in the GCSE examinations, awarding 58 points for an A* grade, (see table below). Short Course grades are allocated half the number of points as the full course equivalent.

This total per student gives the Uncapped Score. For the Capped Score, each student's best 8 GCSE's only are counted. The total per student is then divided by the total number of students on roll to give the average.

Other qualifications are now also credited, including Graded Music exams.
