

SYDENHAM SCHOOL PROVIDER ACCESS STATEMENT 2018

Statement on Provider Access

This statement sets out the school's arrangements for managing the access of providers to pupils at the school for the purposes of giving them information about the provider's education or training offer. This complies with the school's legal obligations under Section 42B of the Education Act 1997.

Student entitlement

All students in years 8-13 are entitled:

- To find out about technical education qualifications and apprenticeships opportunities, as part of a careers programme which provides information on the full range of education and training options available at each transition point.
- To hear from a range of local providers about the opportunities they offer, including technical education and apprenticeships – through options evenings, assemblies and group discussions and careers and further/higher education events.
- To understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses.

Premises and facilities

This will all be discussed and agreed in advance of the visit with the Careers Leader or a member of their team.

Providers are welcome to leave a copy of their prospectus or other relevant course literature at the Careers Resource Centre, which is managed by the school librarian, or in the Career Coordinator's office. The Resource Centre is available to all students at lunch and break times and after school.
