

Nursery rated as "outstanding"

A NURSERY school in Chelmsford has been singled out as one of the top in the county.

Tanglewood Nursery School, in Melbourne Avenue, has been judged as outstanding three times by Ofsted inspectors.

The nursery school is highlighted as one of Essex's best providers for young children in the Ofsted annual report which has just been published.

In Essex, 27 schools, 85 childcare providers and two social care providers were judged to be outstanding.

Headteacher at Tanglewood Ann Barker said: "We are passionate about the children's learning and continually strive to seek the very best care and nursery education for our children."

Other schools described as outstanding in the report in the Chelmsford area are Jack and Jill Full Day Nursery at West Hanningfield, Small Wonders Day Nursery and Out of School Care in Main Road, Rettendon Common, the Duckling Nursery School in Lodge Road, Writtle and Newlands Spring Primary School in Chelmsford and the Tyrells School in Tavistock Road, Springfield.
