Analysis of Questionnaire and Comments Made

100% of participants responded to say they agree their child feels happy and safe at Tanglewood and is well looked after and they would all recommend Tanglewood to other parents.

98% agree their child makes good progress at Tanglewood (1 person didn't answer, 1 didn't know).

97% agree their child is taught well (2 people didn't know). 97% receive valuable information from the school about their child's progress (1 disagreed and 1 didn't know and 1 didn't answer).

What would make Tanglewood better?

7 responded longer hours

13 said more communication and timely feedback

1 said flexible hours

1 said potty training

1 said cooking

1 said parent joining in sessions

1 said bringing more child made keepsakes home

1 said less crowded pick-ups (more organisation around this)

Response from school

Longer/Flexible Hours - At present we do not have the capacity to extend the number of hours or offer flexible hours, as every classroom is full and we have a waiting list for both Tanglewood and Little Tanglewood. However, this is an area where we constantly revisit and review the options and it may be something we could offer in the future.

Communication & Feedback - We hope we have addressed the issues around communication and feedback in the newsletter and will address this more directly in our upcoming parent consultation meetings.

Potty Training - The classroom staff in both Little Tanglewood and Tanglewood are always there to offer support and advice around potty training and we will help families who are working towards this.

Cooking- We are always cooking in Tanglewood - This usually comes from the children's interests/learning that week. However, we can always do more!

Parent Workshops - We are hoping to build in more parent workshops, come & play sessions and coffee morning across this year but we are always open to any further suggestions that parents have. Watch the newsletter for any information and dates of upcoming events.

Keepsakes – We take on board the comments made and will talk about this in our curriculum meetings.

Pick Ups – Over the past year the drop off/pick up times have been reviewed and various strategies have been tried. We will keep this under review as the year goes on and monitor how crowded the corridors are.
