

Outstanding Teaching & Beyond

Do you love teaching, but struggle to find a CPD programme for post-NQT teachers focussing on pedagogy rather than leadership? Enthusiastic about learning more about current thinking on good pedagogy, and enjoy sharing your own thoughts and expertise with others?

The programme consists of **6 twilight sessions** which will be themed around **6 key claims about outstanding pedagogy** that have been taken from an exhaustive analysis of research. Taking these claims as a starting point, you will interrogate exactly what these features of outstanding teaching look like in the classroom, observing them in other’s lessons, and exploring them in your own.

By taking part in this programme you will gain:

- Enriched knowledge of **current research** about what makes outstanding teaching
- The opportunity to rigorously analyse what the classrooms of outstanding practitioners look like through a structured **peer-observation programme**
- Certification which will **enrich your CV**, especially if you are hoping to develop your career through classroom-based routes like Lead Practitioner or mentoring based routes
