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Dear Families

Year 8 End of Year Mathematics Examination

All year 8 students will be sitting their end of year mathematics examination in the form of two 45-minute papers on Thursday 20th June (non-calculator paper) and Friday 21st June (calculator paper). This will occur in their normal mathematics lesson and classroom.

The examination will cover all work learnt in Year 8 and resources to support the students are available in the year 8 mathematics area on Google classrooms:

- students have already been asked to complete the “End of Year Revision Booklet Part 1”, which contains practice questions;
- select “Topic List and Learning Journeys” for documents detailing the modules that have been taught, with references to pages in the text book; and,
- select “Text Book” for PDF versions of the text book and the homework book.

In addition, your child can use their MyMaths account to access further practice and explanation on any of the topics covered this year.

We recommend that your child does at least twenty minutes of revision every day before their examination. This revision should be focused on the topics that they find most difficult and might include:

- watching lessons on MyMaths;
- completing MyMaths exercises; and,
- practising questions from the homework book or text book.

Your child’s class teacher will also give some time for revision in class and support your child in their preparation.
