Year 12 Geography Fieldwork Residential Trip February 2018

A requirement of the Geography A Level is to complete a minimum of four days fieldwork at contrasting locations in both the physical and human geographical environment. In order to provide the best teaching and resources for your child I have arranged for students to spend three days, this academic year, at the Fields Studies Council centre at Juniper Hall, Surrey.

The timings and dates of this trip will be from the afternoon of Monday 26 February to the evening of Wednesday 28 February 2018. The cost per student is £200. And this includes full tuition from experienced practitioners with access to knowledge, equipment and resources; accommodation for two nights, which will be full board for Tuesday and Wednesday and includes the Monday evening meal. Travel costs to and from the centre and during the stay are also included.

The group will be leaving Teddington School at 3.00pm on Monday 26 February and returning on Wednesday evening at approximately 8.00pm.

The reason that this is a residential trip is so that students can access field sites which are further afield and will be able to use the full working day including the evening. This trip will be in conjunction with Chancellor's School who are also studying AQA Geography and this will reduce costs and enhance the learning experience. This has taken some time to negotiate hence the late notice for the field trip.

Further information including kit lists and Juniper Hall information will be sent out in the next few weeks.
