Re: Thorpe Park Fright Night – change of date - 31 October 2017

Due to a clerical error by Thorpe Park, we have had to change the date of our rewards trip to the venue to after half term on Tuesday 31 October.

After negotiating with the company and I am pleased to announce that the price of the tickets will remain the same and all other practical arrangements for the evening stay the same.

The cost of the deposit will still be £10.00 per student which will secure a place on the coach. However, due to the date change, we are happy to refund the deposit to any student who is unable to make the new date due to prior commitments.

Please complete the below permission slip by **Monday 16 October** to re-register your interest in this trip and indicate which ticket price option you would like to opt for. You may also include full payment with this permission slip in a sealed envelope if you so wish.

Please see information about ticket options below:

- Standard ticket price (no Merlin pass) = £14.00 remaining to pay.
- Thorpe Park Merlin Pass holders = £14.00 (even with this pass, the cost of a no school group ticket would be £15.00 as no bulk school discount is applicable).
- Merlin Premium Pass Holders = students must reserve their own ticket online to receive it at a cost of £1.00. These tickets cannot be reserved through a school booking.

The remaining balance must be paid by **Wednesday 18 October 2017**. No places will be available after this date. Payments can be made at any point during this time by cash, cheque or via ParentPay.

In cases of financial hardship it may still be possible to attend this trip at a reduced cost. Please write to the Headteacher, in confidence outlining the circumstances and in certain cases, it may be possible to seek financial assistance.

I would like to apologise for the inconvenience caused by this change of date but I hope that as many year 10 students as possible will be able to take part. However, any incidents of poor behaviour in the weeks leading up to 31 October may result in students being removed from the trip. Should this happen the deposit paid is non-refundable.
