



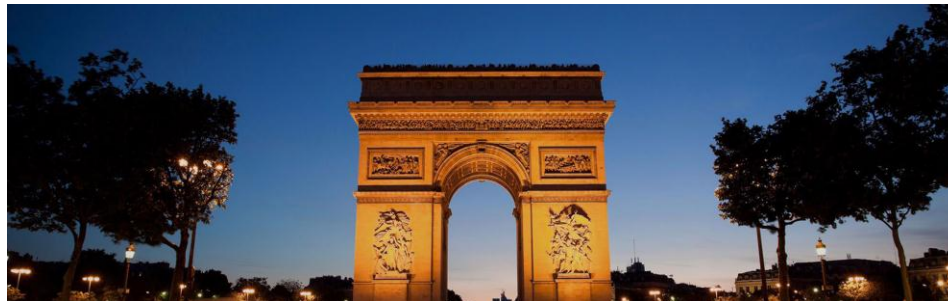

What to bring?



Luggage: 1 small holdall & 1 piece of hand luggage

- The suggested amount for students to bring is approximately £60 (changed into euros)

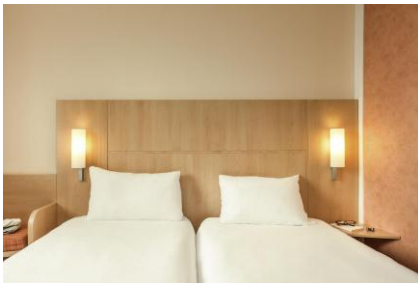
