

# Parents Meeting for German Exchange 28<sup>th</sup> September – 5<sup>th</sup> October



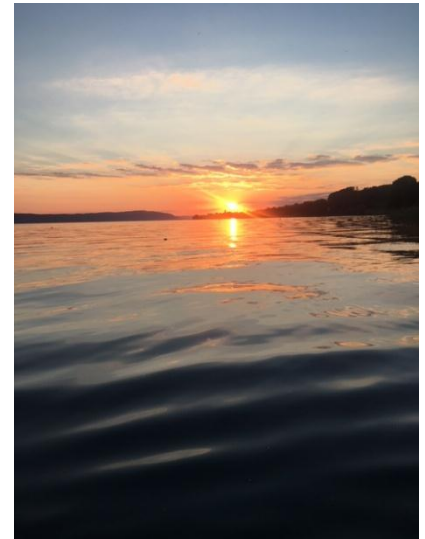
# The Welcome - Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> September

- Group land at 13:25 expected to arrive from 15:00
- Our students to meet them in the restaurant area.  
Leave lesson 15 mins early.
- Bring food for their arrival – see sign up sheet
- Getting home – remember they will have to carry luggage



## Friday 29<sup>th</sup> September

- Visit Teddington School
- German pupils in school for tutor time, lesson 1 and 2.
- Break with English students. At 11am meet at reception, they walk to Hampton Court Palace
- return at 3.30 pm. Meet in school reception.



# The weekend 30<sup>th</sup> September – 1<sup>st</sup> October

# Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> and Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> October

## Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> October

- German students travel into London with their teachers to visit Tower of London
- Watch Wicked at 14:30
- Arrive back at chosen station at 18:00

- German students stay local - Kingston
- Coach leaves Thursday afternoon at 14:00, students will be allowed out of lessons to say goodbye

# Safety

- Please make sure that your German partner knows your address and phone number, however they should never be left alone
- Advise partner on safety as you would your own child, you are in loco parentis
- Avoid high risk activities
