Duke of Edinburgh Silver



From Saturday 5 to Monday 7 May, 46 students from Years 10, 11 and 12 undertook their practice Silver Duke of Edinburgh expedition in Sussex. They had some refresher training with the assessors at Blackland Farm in East Grinstead on Saturday, undertook their first hike to Heaven Farm in Uckfield and on the last day hiked to the finish point in Ashdown Forest. They hiked approximately 40 km over the three days. They will complete their assessed expedition in July which will run over 3 days and two nights. Students who have completed their bronze award undertake six months of volunteering for their silver award in addition to three months on their physical and skills sections, but if they have not done the Bronze, they must undertake a further 6 months in either the volunteering or the longer of the Physical or Skills sections.

This is an initiative run by the Colleges of the University of Oxford aimed at academically able students at non-selective UK state schools. They had an introduction to higher education and student finance, interactive sessions with current students, lunch served in the college dining hall and took part in academic activities including mini lectures in anthropology and medieval literature. The University has generous non-repayable bursaries and tuition fee reductions for full-time UK students with qualifying household incomes.
