Count on Us Maths Success



Congratulations to our Year 9 students Georgia Dobson and Yva Baker and Year 8 students George Bannon, Nicholas Fleming and Sam Bates, who have taken Teddington School through to the semi finals of the Mayor of London's new Maths competition –Count on Us". They came first in their heat on Friday 26 April and were the only school to finish the final round.

The Count on Us Secondary Challenge is a pan-London maths tournament for Year 8 and 9 pupils delivered in partnership with the Jack Petchey Foundation. By combining a series of mental arithmetic and problem solving tasks, the Secondary Challenge helps pupils become confident mathematicians, developing mathematical fluency and improving problem solving skills.

Participating schools received teacher training, a range of maths resources as well as teacher and pupil workbooks. The resources are implemented in schools with pupils honing their skills via in-school or inter-school tournaments. Teams are selected with five pupils chosen to represent their school in local heats, with qualifying schools making it through to the semi-finals and grand finale at City Hall. The semi-final in June will see our students compete against 24 schools from 7 heats.

About 120 selected students from Year 7 and Year 8 have also taken part in the Junior Mathematical Challenge run by the UK Mathematics Trust which organises national mathematics competitions and other mathematical enrichment activities for 11-18 year olds including running the UK's biggest national maths competitions.

Year 9 student Annabel Leyden received her prize this week for her entry "Every Body is Perfect" in the annual Fourth Plinth Schools Award 2019. Justine Simons, Deputy Mayor for Culture and Creative Industries and the artist Gillian Wearing presented the prizes at the ceremony at City Hall London. Annabel won her prize for the Richmond Borough entry. All 33 boroughs in London took part and there was a prize for the winning entry in each borough. In total there were over 3,250 entries. The standard was very high and the range of creative ideas was inspiring. The winning entries are on show at City Hall from 1 May for 6 weeks.



Over Easter, Year 8 were tasked with designing and making a model satellite. The science department are very impressed with the detail and effort put into each design. Students were asked to think about ensuring their designs were strong but light, how the satellites will be powered, which communications equipment they will include and protecting their satellites from temperature and weather elements, no easy task! The satellite models created by each student are all very unique and made to such high quality that it was a mammoth task in deciding the top three. After much contemplation, the top 10 satellites were decided, with the best designs awarded to Sam Gibson, Lois King and Mark Kindness. A huge well done to all students for completing this homework to such an excellent standard, and the 3 finalists... not only will you receive a small prize but also listen out carefully as you have been nominated for the headteacher's award!






