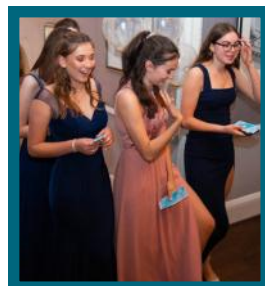

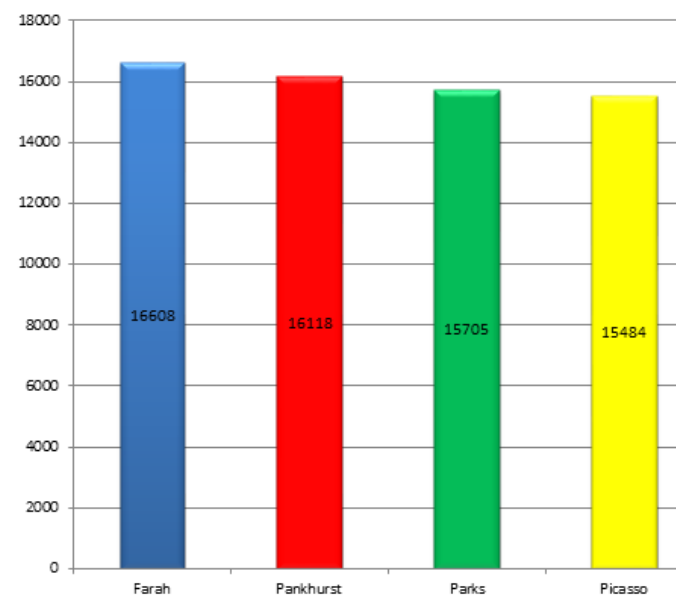

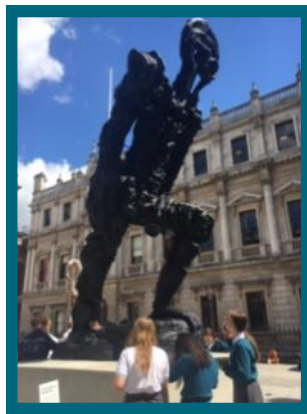
## This Week in School

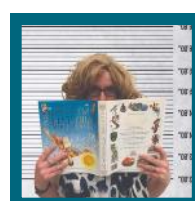
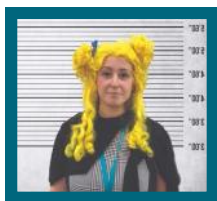
