Teddington Sixth Form Update

We are delighted to celebrate the recent A Level performance tables which place Teddington Sixth Form third in the London Borough of Richmond for progress, and the highest ranking non fee-paying institution. We achieved a progress score of 0.32 classed as 'well above average' which means that students at Teddington Sixth Form achieved 1/3 of a grade above students with the same starting level in other schools.
