Look at the 'Mock exam paper' and read carefully.

### Hwk Tasks:

1. Choose 1 of the 4 exam question briefs e.g. 'Self image'
2. Each question has a number of relevant artists to investigate. Choose 2 to 3 artists to study and evaluate in an 'Artist research page format' in your sketchbook *Success criteria: remember to include quality analysis of their overall style of working and techniques, as well as analysis of at least one of their photos to back this up. Include at least 3 images of their work and make the overall presentation relevant to their style where possible.*
3. Inspired by the Artists you have studied take a Photoshoot for each *Success criteria: remember to start with a 'shoot plan' mini paragraph /mind map of ideas following on from artists research, take a minimum of 30 photos for each shoot and present in a contact sheet, annotate the sheet.*
4. Edit and Present a minimum 3-5 great images from each shoot with an evaluation *Success criteria: explain what you have done and why and how it relates back to your shoot plan, theme and artists.*

**Please note:** If you are struggling to use the exam questions/ brief on their own you can choose an alternative starting point from the below list. You can also use any of the alternative artists from the list as long as their work fits in with your chosen question/brief.
