Dear Families

Following a number of isolated incidents today involving students wishing to revise independently in the school building, I must reiterate the expectations for all Year 11 students during the examinations period for which I welcome your support.

Year 11 students should only be on site if they are in an examination or in one of the sessions on the modified timetabled which is in effect a continuation of their regular timetable. If students do not wish to participate in the timetabled sessions and do not have a scheduled examination then they should not be on the school site but revising at home. Students are welcome to take their own revision work which they can do silently in the modified timetable sessions even if this is for another subject.

We have a duty of care to ensure all students on site are safe and supervised at all times. They cannot therefore revise anywhere other than the allocated rooms, as it is not possible to guarantee supervision in all of these spaces whilst continuing to provide lessons and support to students in Years 7-13.

This message has been communicated again with all Year 11 students this afternoon.

Once again thank you for your support and may I take this opportunity to wish the Year 11 students the best of luck in their exams.
