Year 7 Kingswood Adventure Trip

I am delighted to let you know that your child has been accepted onto the residential trip on the 29 September – 1 October to Grosvenor Hall in Kent.

Students should come to school on Friday in their uniform, and will change on arrival at Kingswood Centre. Bags should be stored in the Quiet Room at the back of the Library on arrival at school, and will be picked up at the end of Period 5 before setting off by coach. No special equipment is required for the trip, but smart clothes should be avoided as there is every chance of getting muddy or wet (depending on the weather), so a change into dry clothes for the evenings is recommended. For the activities, students should wear long trousers and shirts with long sleeves, and trainers. A warm jumper or track suit top and rain jacket would both be advisable in case the weather turns cold or wet, or for the cooler evenings. Refillable water bottles are also a good idea.

Students should bring their own toiletries and towels, but all bedding will be provided. All meals will be provided as part of the fee, but you may wish to provide your child with a small allowance for cash purchases of snacks between meals. It is not recommended that your child brings valuable items such as iPads or large sums of money with them.

If you have not yet returned the green medical form in your induction pack advising the school of any medical or dietary needs your child may have, please do so now.

I would be grateful if you could pay the outstanding amount for the trip through Parentpay by Tuesday 25 September.

We should return to Teddington School by about 3.00pm on Sunday, at which point students will be free to be picked up or go home directly.
