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Dear Families

All Year 9 students will be sitting two 45 minute end of Key Stage 3 exams in May. The dates for these exams are Tuesday 21 May (non-calculator) and Wednesday 22 May (calculator) in their normal maths lesson and classroom. Students not taught maths on Wednesday 22 May will write the exam in the same period as the other classes when they have ICT in their normal maths room.

The exam will cover all work learnt in Year 9 and resources to support the students are available in the Year 9 maths area on Google classrooms:

- Select "Revision Booklet" for a document which lists the topics to be tested on and contains practice questions. Their class teacher will be guiding them in the use of this document.
- Select "Learning Journeys" for documents showing the details of each module that has been taught, with references to pages in the text book.
- The modules to be examined are Algebra 1 & 2, Number 1 & 2, Statistics 1 & 2, and Geometry 1, 2 & 3.
- Select "Text Books" for PDF versions of the text book and the homework book. At the end of each chapter in the text book is a consolidation exercise which is an ideal revision resource, and the previous pages in each chapter may be used as a revision guide. Additionally, students may use the homework book to improve on topics identified through the consolidation exercises.
- Please note that all the resources available in FireFly are now available in Google Classrooms. Your child was set a task this week to allow them to access the Year 9 Google Classroom. Please ensure that they have done this.

Your child's class teacher will also give some time for revision in class and support them in their preparation.

Following the Year 9 exams and feedback, your child will start their GCSE course. Set 4 will study for the Foundation Tier. Sets 1 and 2 will study for the Higher Tier. Set 3 will study for the Higher Tier until the end of year 10 exam, when we will be in a position to assess on which tier they are most likely to achieve their best grade.
