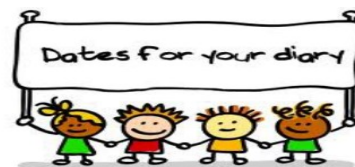


Parent Workshops

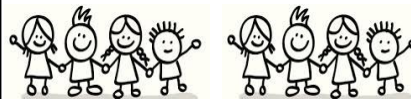


Attendance Stars
