We would like to congratulate all our sixth form students and staff who worked so hard to achieve another set of fantastic results, exceeding the targets set. Nearly half of all A Level or equivalent qualifications achieved A*-B, with a quarter achieving an A or A*.



These results are particularly impressive when we consider the significant changes in the new A level and BTEC qualifications, with more content and greater emphasis on exams. Our students have risen to the challenge of the new qualifications with determination and ambition, balancing their work and family commitments alongside their studies.
