## Key Year 11 Dates

I am writing to inform/remind you of a few key events in the Year 11 diary.

On **Tuesday 16 January 2018**, we will be hosting the Year 11 Parents Information Evening. On the evening I will be outlining key events for the remainder of the academic year. Ms Ramsden will be talking to parents/carers about key curriculum features, including the mock feedback process, and we will also have a presentation from our Director of Sixth Form. This evening has been placed a week before Year 11 Parents' Evening to ensure that students, parents and staff can maximise that consultation time. The event will run from **18:30 - 19:30** and will take place in the school hall.

We can now confirm that the Year 11 Tolworth Girls' School Prom will take place on **Friday 29 June 2018**. The girls will come into school on that day for their Graduation Assembly in Period 1, followed by an exclusive Year 11 assembly with myself in Period 2. Following that, they will be dismissed at 11:00 allowing them plenty of time to go home and prepare for Prom.

The anticipated price for tickets is £35.00 each, but we will be looking at ways to possibly reduce this through fundraising in the Spring Term.
