Prom Passports

All students have recently been issued with their Prom Passports. They need to successfully complete these in order to attend the Prom. All students need to get their cards completed to show that they have attended their timetabled Practical Week interventions and a minimum of five additional interventions outside of Practical Week. Students with lower Attitude to Learning scores also have targets in relation to homework completion. A few students have targets in relation to being on time for school. We also of course expect all students to be excellent role models for younger students.

Plan for the Final Weeks of Year 11

The GCSE exams are now very close and we want to share with you our plan for this last period of time. We are currently in the middle of Practical Week; students are completing practical assessments and attending intervention sessions. After Practical Week, students will have five more weeks of the normal timetable.

From Monday 14 May, GCSE exams start and students will be following an amended timetable. Many lessons will run as normal but with adjustments to ensure that students always have subject-specific revision directly before an exam. There will be no form time so the school day will end at 2:50pm. Most students will be in school full-time during this period. There are some students who will have study leave during Period 1 and/or Period 5 on one or two days. This will be clearly indicated on their individual timetables. On Friday 25 May, the GCSE English Literature exam is in the morning and all students will have study leave after the exam finishes.

After the half-term break, all students will have study leave and will only be required to come into school for exams and revision classes. GCSEs finish on Friday 22 June. Tuesday 26 and Wednesday 27 June will be Sixth Form 'Bridging the Gap' days. The Year 11 Graduation Assembly and Prom are on Friday 29 June.
