Whole School Curriculum Day - Wednesday 14 November 2018 Year 11 - Speaking and Listening Preparation and Maths Mock Exam

As part of the next whole school curriculum day, your daughter will spend half of her session in English, preparing for her Speaking and Listening qualification.

As part of the new specifications at GCSE, students are expected to complete a Speaking and Listening performance that will be awarded a separate certificate. Whilst this does not contribute to their overall GCSE in English Language, students will be awarded with a Pass, Merit, Distinction or Not Classified; it is an excellent opportunity to gain confidence in public speaking. The skills required to write their speeches will also enable students to practise crucial elements needed to complete the writing section of their Component 2 English Language exam.

The other half of the day will be spent in Maths, where students will take part in a revision session and then sit a mock exam paper. This exam will count towards their Maths mock exam result for December 2018. Kindly remind your daughter to have her Maths equipment in a clear pencil case as equipment will not be provided for the exam.

Students should arrive in school as normal for an 8:30am start. AEGJ students will start in English, whilst OPST will begin their day in Maths after they register in their tutor groups; this will swap after sessions 1 and 2. The Windmill Cafe will be open as usual for lunch and the day will finish at 3:25pm. Students are required to wear their school uniform and should bring their English exercise books and pencil cases with them.
