Year 11 Key Dates: Mock Exams and Information Evenings for Parents

I am writing to give you the dates of the Year 11 mock exams. This year, the main mock exam period is from Monday 11 December 2017 to Wednesday 20 December 2017 inclusive. Your daughter was given the overall timetable some time ago to allow her to start planning revision but she will shortly be receiving her individual timetable. This will list all the exams she is sitting over the mock exam period. She may also have some intervention sessions listed during the second week. These sessions will be designed to support your daughter in plugging gaps in knowledge.

During the mock exam period your daughter will only be required to attend school for exams and interventions. Study rooms will be provided for those students who have a gap between exams. Students must sign in and out each time they come into school throughout the mock period and the girls must wear full school uniform.

In addition to the exams, during the main mock exam window, there will also be mocks in Maths on 13, 20 and 22 November 2017 and in Science on 6 December 2017 and 9 and 18 January 2018. You will have already received information about this from the relevant departments.

Mock exam results will be published on Friday 12 January 2018. On Tuesday 16 January 2018 we will be holding a Year 11 Parents' Information Evening. At this evening we will provide information on how you can support your daughter in the final two terms of Year 11. There is also a Year 11 Parents' Evening on Tuesday 23 January 2018. This evening will be your opportunity to talk to subject teachers and get specific advice about how your daughter can maximise her grade in each subject.

I would like to take this opportunity to congratulate our Year 11 students on their excellent attitude towards learning. I am sure that their hard work will reap rewards and look forward to celebrating an excellent set of mock results in January.
