Whole School Curriculum Day - Wednesday 14 November 2018 Year 7 - Being Safe

I am writing to inform you that there will be a Whole School Curriculum Day on Wednesday 14 November 2018. On this day the normal timetable will be suspended to allow students the opportunity to explore a theme in depth.

Year 7 are currently working on the Snapback resilience programme in tutorial. The unit is all about how we take care of ourselves in life, both physically and emotionally and also develop resilience to tackle obstacles faced in life. This Curriculum Day will be an extension of this unit and will cover the following:

- road safety
- e-safety
- stranger danger
- body image

This is a really important day where students will engage with issues relevant to young people today. They will also have a safety talk from Police Officers on the day. Our aim is for students to be able to sensibly navigate through some of the challenges which lie ahead of them, and to give them information to help them to make wise choices.
