## Results

Please be aware that results cannot be given over the telephone or to anyone else, unless written authority is produced. We will of course post results to anyone unable to come in and if you wish this to occur then a stamped addressed envelope should be passed to the Examinations Office before the end of the summer term. If you have moved during the last year then please provide us with a written note of the address, even if you are planning to come into school to collect the results.

## Results Consultation

Members of the Sixth Form team will be available in school on Thursday 16 August between 9.00am and 1.00pm in the foyer and in the library to discuss any issues that may arise from your results. I have every confidence that most of you will gain the places that you have been offered at Universities, however a few words about clearing just in case:

- If your grades are below your offers you can immediately telephone the university concerned. You must have your UCAS number with you and credit on your mobile phone. They may still take you but it will depend on the course and institution in question. We can help you but many universities will not take calls from schools for the first couple of day's post-results. Also the Data Protection Act means that the Universities will want to deal with you directly, not us or your parents.
- If you are rejected by both your first choice and insurance offers, there are strategies to make the clearing process more likely to be successful for you and we will provide all the advice that you need at the time. National newspapers publish 'Clearing' information on results day and if you are thinking of applying through Clearing then the sooner you do this the better your chances! Alternatively your local careers office will give you sound advice about alternative options for you.
- If your grades are above your firm offer you may be eligible for UCAS adjustment, please see UCAS.com for details.

Whatever your future plans, we wish you every success in your forthcoming examinations.
