- **Biology** – Grade 6 in Biology or a Grade 7 -9 in Double Science/Core and Additional Science, and a Grade 6 in GCSE Maths
- **Chemistry** – Grade 6 in Chemistry or a Grade 7-9 in Double Science/Core and Additional Science and a Grade 6 in Maths
- **Computer Science** – Grade 6 at GCSE in Mathematics
- **Drama** – Grade 6 in GCSE English Literature. Please note, a preference will be given to those who also achieve a Grade 6 in GCSE Drama and a Grade 6 in GCSE English Language
- **Economics** – Grade 6 in GCSE English Language and Grade 6 in GCSE Maths
- **Engineering** – Grade 6 in both Core and Additional Science (equivalent to two GCSEs)
- **English Literature** – Grade 6 in GCSE English Literature and a Grade 6 in English Language
- **Fine Art** – Grade 6 in GCSE Art and Design
- **Further Mathematics** – Grade 8 in GCSE Mathematics
- **Geography** – Grade 6 in GCSE Geography
