1:1 Foundation iPad Scheme

As you are aware, we have recently undertaken the first stages in implementing a 1:1 iPad scheme for all Foundation students within UCL Academy. Over the last month we have contacted all families offering their child access to an iPad at a cost of between £0-£14 a month.

If you are interested in this scheme you will by now have either completed the online Direct Debit Form (accessed through the school website), a paper Direct Debit form or informed the school that you would like your child to have access to a 1:1 iPad.

Now that you have agreed to be part of the scheme the next stage is to attend a **parent and student information evening at 5.30pm on Tuesday the 12th of April**. During this meeting the Home School Agreement will be discussed. Parents and students agreeing to and signing this Agreement will receive the iPad within a matter of days.

We are working closely with the e-Learning Foundation to ensure that iPads are activated and in the hands of students by Friday the 15th of April. Completing the Home School Agreement is the next vital step in this process.

With regards to payments, if you have signed up to the Direct Debit donation method then the first payment will be taken from your account 1 month after the iPad is provided to your child through the school.

If you have further questions about the e-learning programme, would like to sign up to contribute £10 a month towards the cost of the programme, or enquire into how your child may access a device when in receipt of Free School Meals and Pupil Premium Funding, feel free to email Mr Khan at i.khan@uclacademy.co.uk.
