What is the Early Years Foundation Stage?

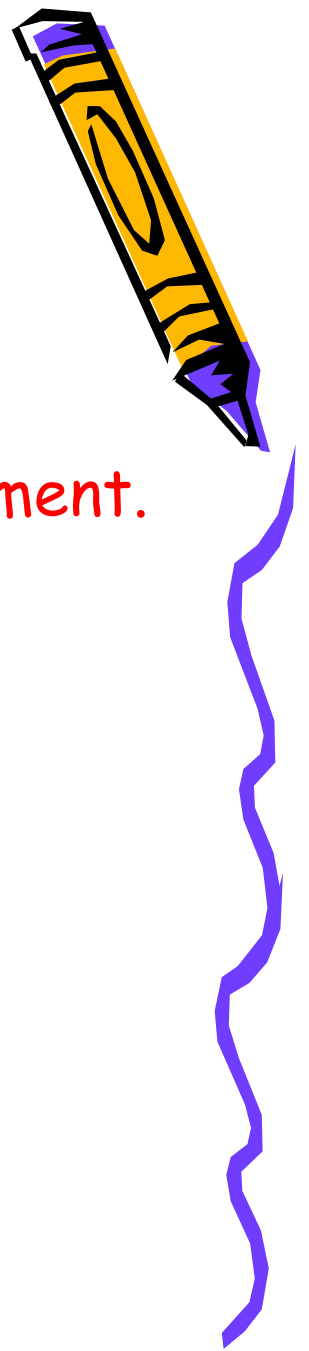


The **E**arly **Y**ears **F**oundation **S**tage (**E.Y.F.S.**) is the stage of education for children from **birth** to the **end of the Reception year**.

It is based on the recognition that children learn best through **play and active learning**.

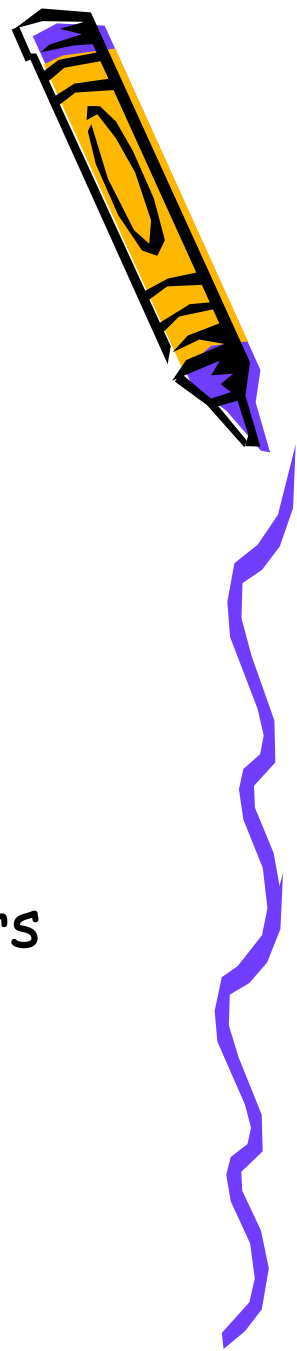
Suitable Clothing

Welfare Matters

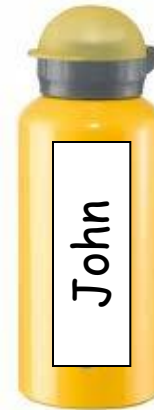
- Medical Needs.
- Administration of medicines requires prior written consent.
- Allergies.
- Sickness and Diarrhoea - 48 hours clear absence must follow.
- Temperature above 37.5 degrees - 24 hours absence must follow.
- Little upsets.

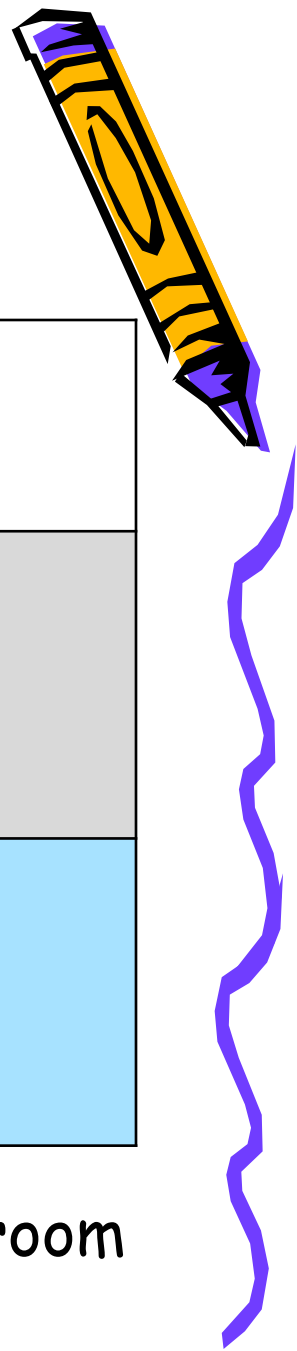

You will be visited between 9am & 11.45am

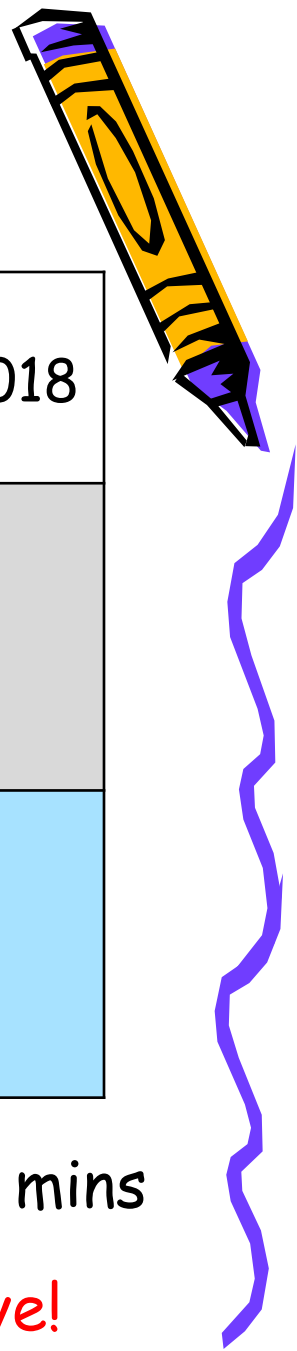

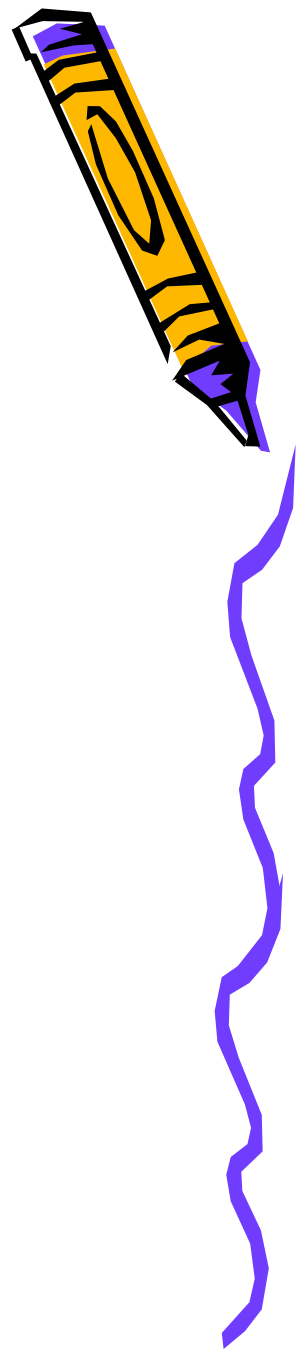


Starting at Vaughan
