SELECTIVE ELIGIBILITY TEST TUESDAY 17 SEPTEMBER 2019

This page gives details of the test arrangements for Tuesday 17 September 2019

You will have received an email giving your child's designated test centre, candidate number and where to report to on arrival. **Please print the email and provide your child with a copy to bring to the exam. This is needed on arrival. Please do not try to show us your child's candidate number on your smartphone.** For Wallington High School for Girls there are 2 sessions and the details of which session you have been allocated to will be in your e mail. **You can only sit the exam at the session you have been allocated.**

WHAT TO DO ON ARRIVAL:

Please bring your daughter, on foot, to the side entrance in Woodmansterne Lane (as in 2018) where you will be directed onto the school grounds to queue. Please note this is a change from previous years.

Your daughter must bring a printed copy of the e mail invitation you have received along with the items listed further down this page.

Your child will have an allocated seat for the test and will be taken to that seat by a prefect.

For the first session, Gates will open from 8.45am. Gates will close at 9.00a.m. Testing will start at 9.15am and should be completed by 11.30am. Please note the end time is approximate and we would welcome your patience on the day.

For the second session, entry will be from 1pm. Gates will close at 1.15pm. Testing will start at 1.30pm and should be completed by 3.45pm. Please note the end time is approximate and we would welcome your patience on the day.

Will parents please leave promptly once they have delivered their children to the correct area.

WHAT TO DO AT PICK-UP:

Please enter the school grounds, on foot, again from the side entrance in Woodmansterne Lane and collect your daughter from the School Hall.

For the first session please collect from 11.30am

For the second session please collect from 3.45pm

Please note the end time for both sessions is approximate and we would welcome your patience on the day.

Do not tell your child to meet you outside the school.

Please ensure that you read the information on the website about travel to Wallington High School for Girls. There will be no parking available on site. You are strongly recommended to use public transport. If you do arrive by car please ensure that you park a good distance away from the school, considerately and safely, so as not to inconvenience local residents. Please note that parking enforcement will be in place.

Candidates must bring the following items with them in a clear pencil case or small clear plastic bag (large bags or backpacks are not permitted)-

- **A printout of the email giving their candidate number and zone. This is very important.**

- **2 HB or B pencils**
- **A good quality rubber**
- **A pencil sharpener**
- **A ruler**

They may also bring:-

- **A bottle of water – no fizzy drinks please – and a small snack (no nuts) for the break.**
- **A book to read during the break (this is optional and has nothing to do with the exam).**
- **A jumper or fleece.**
- **If rain is forecast please bring a coat with a hood**

Your child should NOT bring a mobile telephone, smart watch or any other electronic device, any backpack/carrier bag etc, a calculator or calculator watch; any piece of stationery which displays times tables or other such information or a dictionary.

If you have decided that you do not wish your child to sit the selective eligibility test after all, please will you email the Admissions Team at the school (admissions@girlslearningtrust.org) as soon as you receive your candidate number.
