Dear Parent(s)/Carer(s)

In the event of extreme bad weather conditions during winter months, a decision to close the school may have to be made. We will send a text/voice message home via the Group Call system and inform Wessex FM (97.2) and 2CR (102.3) of our decision, who will then broadcast the information. If the school is **NOT** mentioned then we are open as usual. This procedure works well if we have to close the school before the normal start time in the morning.

If bad weather develops during the day, and a decision to close the school is made; again we will contact Wessex FM (97.2) and 2CR (102.3), and text/voice messages will be sent home via the Group Call system.

Please can you complete and return the permission slip below to confirm if you wish your child to remain in school until collected or for them to be sent home if the decision is made to close the school.

If consent is granted for your child to be sent home, this will remain valid until you contact the school, in writing, to cancel it.
