School Uniform Reminders

No leggings are to be worn under skirts or dresses."

Hairstyles (boys and girls) should be simple and of the child's natural colour. Fashion /extreme styles/shaven heads are not acceptable. No 'tram lines' or heads shaved too severely. No other jewellery is allowed and all jewellery must be removed for PE.
