Y5 Weald and Downland Open Air Museum

On Thursday 15th November 2018, Y5 embarked on a thrilling trip to the Weald & Downland Open Air Museum. It was a trip that we were all eagerly looking forward to. The excitement began as soon as we arrived. Welly boots on, all 89 children and teachers trekked up steep, muddy hills to get to the Downland Gridshell (an enormous modern piece of architecture). It resembled a huge noughts and crosses grid! The place was vast. At this point we were split into 5 groups - each had the opportunity of exploring different activities and workshops, which included a chance to experience what life was like during several different time periods, such as Anglo Saxons, early dwellings of the Middle Ages, Tudors, together with the Victorians.

In Tudor times, 90/100 people were involved in farming the land, whereas nowadays only 4/100 people do it. Many of the houses were made of wattle & daub which is a mixture of woven twigs and hay, covered in cow manure and clay which would have been sourced from natural resources (the ground). 12:30pm = lunch, we were all starving! After a refreshing snacky meal, we split into 2 groups. One explored rural life through the ages while the other made delicious smokey bread all from fresh ingredients. We all thoroughly enjoyed our day and left exhausted.
