Of the 448 pupils attending Wormholt Park Primary School 89.3% live within 1 kilometre of the school (400 pupils) 93.8% live within 2 kilometres of the school (420 pupils) 96.7% live within 3 kilometres of the school (433 pupils) The school is situated in the Wormholt and White City Ward in a densely populated area of primarily social housing. The school is within 800 metres south of the A40 Westway, one of the busiest routes from the west into central London and a similar distance north of Uxbridge Road. The Queens Park Rangers football stadium on nearby Loftus Road has a dramatic effect on volume of traffic in the area on matchdays and the Westfield shopping development has also increased traffic in the local area.
